**HIGH SCHOOL TRANSITION MEETINGS** - Freshmen, if you did not complete your 8<sup>th</sup> to 9<sup>th</sup> grade transition meeting, please call Mrs. Esquivel to schedule an appointment with the counselor. The goal of this mandatory meeting is to provide academic counseling regarding high school. Students and at least one parent or guardian must meet with the counselor to discuss credits and requirements necessary for high school graduation.

**NCAA REGISTRATION** – It is time for college-bound student-athletes to register with the NCAA Eligibility Center. Who Should Register? Any current high school sophomore, junior or senior who wishes to participate in collegiate athletics at an NCAA Division I or II college or university should register. How Does Registration Work? Registrants may access the site at [www.eligibilitycenter.org](http://www.eligibilitycenter.org). From the home page, click on "Enter Here" for NCAA college-bound student-athletes, then on the "New Account" link in the upper right corner. From there, simply follow the prompts.

**SENIOR AUDITS** – Senior audits will continue to be held this fall. All seniors must meet with the counselor for their senior audit. The audit is a graduation requirement.
