Treasurer's report

- \$46K in checking and \$30K in savings
- Ahead of budget by \$2K largely due to Snowglobe. Expect that at EOY we will be ahead of budget by \$2K if everything else stays status quo.
- Taxes are complete

New Business

- Snowglobe discussion tabled until more members are in attendance.
- Cheerleading Uniforms - See attached email from Katie to the Boosters regarding her fundraising progress - looks like they are on track to raise the funds as promised.
- 8th Grade Graduation - Ms. Craig convened an 8th grade graduation committee meeting and the plan is to host a beach party with a "ceremony", photo booth, food, etc. at either Glenbrook, RH Pines, or Nevada Beach. Proposed date is Sunday, June 25th which is the day after the HS graduation. Budget is \$1500.

 - Golf Tournament. Mr. Kjer reported that golf tournament fliers are going out and he has been sharing his communications with the "new" team that will take over in 2018.
 - No other reports were given due to the low attendance (snow).

Good Morning!

I just want to update you on the progress the cheerleaders have made with fundraising for our new uniforms.

Back in September, you paid \$5942.20 for the uniforms, with the understanding the cheerleaders would pay back 50% by May 15, 2017. The amount the cheerleaders owe is \$2971.10.

The cheerleaders have held several fundraisers, including two charity nights at Casey's, a Red Hut Burger Night, and hosting Fall Sports Awards.

I confirmed with Casey's last week that they sent a check directly to The Boosters in the amount of \$203 for the cheerleaders' fundraiser on 9/29 and \$186 for the cheerleaders fundraiser on 10/20. Will you please confirm you received these funds, and will be applying it towards the cheerleaders balance of \$2971.10?

I will be depositing \$1244 in cash today from The Red Hut Burger Night.

The cheerleading account as of this morning has \$723.78. Adding the \$1244 in cash plus the \$203 and \$186 paid directly to you from Casey's, the cheerleaders will have \$2356.78 to put towards uniforms, with only \$614.32 left to pay by May 15, 2017.

I am working on some fundraisers to raise the remaining \$614.32. I am happy to pay you \$1485.55, which is half of the \$2971.10, as soon as the cash is in the cheerleaders' account. As promised, I will pay the remaining balance of \$1096.55, which is \$1485.55 minus the \$203 and \$186 paid directly to Boosters, by May 15, which was the original agreement.

I would like to know how Snack Shack hours are applied, since i have parents who have worked in the Snack Shack to raise funds for cheer. Please let me know! Thanks!
