Meeting Called to Order 6:00pm

Minutes: Certified that there was not a quorum

Dana made the motion to approve the last meeting minutes and Kim seconded the motion, passed.

Treasurer's Report: Ed was absent; Kate said we have about \$62,000 in the bank.

We sent out a thank you to Kelly Higgins for running the bonfire event. There was a budget of \$500 for the event we grossed \$388 in revenue and don't have all of the expenses yet.

New Business:

Funding Requests:

Mr. Hight has a \$500 request for Science Bowl's trip to Las Vegas. The total cost of the trip will be \$2280. He is asking that all participates in Science Bowl work 17 hours in the snack shack. They are also hosting the dinner at the Sports Award Dinner. Dana made a motion to fund the Science Bowl \$500 and Kim seconded the motion it passed without one vote. Committee Reports:

Logowear :Logo wear will be sold at Chevron on Kingsbury Grade. The logo wear will be purchased directly from us and they can charge whatever they want at Chevron.

Dana brought up the subject of Rally's Flags, pendants, towels, terrible towels. The towels are \$4 a piece with name and logo, \$2 without name. Dana made a motion that we spend \$381.60 for 144 towels and Kim seconded the motion it passed without one vote. Will have to get the remaining vote online.

Lauren DeSota said we can shop for logo wear online. We asked if she could put the link onto our website for online shopping. She will coordinate with Estella and or Becca.

Christmas Tree Fundraiser: Jennifer Ruby talked about the Christmas Trees tree fundraiser for the baseball team. They will be selling Christmas Trees in the parking lot next to Sushi Pier on Saturday December 6th and 7th. She asked about liability insurance. We told her to call Kelly Higgins or Scott Morgan since a portion of the lot is owned by Douglas County Park and Recreation. They will be putting up banners and putting out fliers. About \$30 a tree will go to GWHS Baseball team.

Stanford Camp: Kim Felton reported that Stanford Camp went well but better communication is needed between the teachers and the camp. A parent needs to take charge of this event next year.

Gym: Kim Felton reported that the No-Echo Program for the new gym is over \$5,000. We will be making calls to businesses and to alumni. Karen Fint is currently in charge of the alumni list.

She said the theater is still there and that we are welcome to salvage any of the sound deafening stuff we would like.
